

Beans (snap/bush): Provider

Phaseolus vulgaris

Quick Facts

- This variety is a fast-maturing bush bean.
- Excellent flavor - a local favorite.
- Disease resistant & cool weather tolerant.
- Can be successfully grown in containers.
- Compact plants are easy to grow and adapt to diverse soil and climate conditions.

Tips

Harvest frequently to encourage new pod sets. For a continuous supply, make successive sowings every 2-3 weeks throughout midsummer. Inoculants can increase yields.

Instructions

Sow when daytime soil temperatures average at least 60° F or risk poor germination.

- Full sun
- Direct seed 2" apart when soil temp is at least 70° F.
- Seed spacing: 1½ - 2 inches
- Plant height: 30 - 36 inches
- Germination: 6 - 10 days
- Mature in 60-65 days
