

Cucumber: Marketmore

Cucumis sativus

Quick Facts

- Matures in 60 days.
- Produces dark green, heirloom, organic 6-8" cucumber.
- 4-6 foot vines continue to produce with regular harvesting.
- Resistant to mosaic virus & powder mildew.
- A favorite slicer for the home garden.

Tips

Plant when soil temperature is at least 70° F. Mulch plants to retain moisture and keep fruits off the ground. Can be grown up a trellis to save space in the garden. Once fruit bearing begins, pick daily to ensure steady harvest.

Instructions

Sow seeds 1-2 weeks after last frost date. Plant in groups of 2 seeds every 12". When 3 leaves appear, thin to 1 plant every 12".

- Full sun
- Seed planting depth: 1/2"
- Seed spacing: 12"
- Row spacing: 36"
- Germination: 7 - 10 days
