

# Peas (shell): Maxigolt

Maxigolt, *Pisum sativum*

## Quick Facts

- Matures 60-65 days from planting.
- Productive 30" vines with 3-4" long pods & 7-8 plump seeds per pod
- Frost tolerant.
- Super sweet Maxigolt shelling peas have an excellent flavor.
- Peas enjoy cool weather; early harvesting yields best results.
- For fall crop, sow 2 months before anticipated frost.

## Tips

Till soil in early spring as soon as it can be worked or in early fall two months before first frost. These shelling peas can reach a height of 36" thus trellising is recommended. Peas are an excellent choice for a children's garden.

## Instructions

Sow directly into a bed or container as soon as soil can be worked. Erect trellis as soon as possible, no more than 3 weeks after planting. Pick frequently to improve results.

- Full sun with well-drained soil
- Seed planting depth: 1 inch
- Seed spacing: 1½ - 2 inches
- Row spacing: 18 - 36 inches
- Plant height: 30 - 36 inches
- Germination: 6 - 10 days
