

# Tomato: Cream Sausage

Solanum lycopersicum

## Quick Facts

- Matures 80 days from transplanting outdoors.
- Produces yellow, elongated, plum-shaped fruits.
- Fruit ripens over a 2 week period.
- Contains meaty flesh with a mild flavor.
- Bushy plants do not require staking.
- Heirloom variety.

## Tips

This variety is great for fresh eating, salsa, and salads. These productive, bushy plants do not require staking; as a result, they work well in containers. Store tomatoes at room temperature for best flavor since chilling may alter the taste and texture.

## Instructions

Plant seeds indoors 6 weeks before last frost. Transplant when soil temperature warms to about 70°.

- Full sun
- Seed planting depth: 1/4"
- Seed spacing: 1½ - 2"
- Row spacing: 24 - 36"
- Plant height: 3 feet
- Germination: 7 - 14 days
